Position Description

The home repair work crew leader position is the bridge between the administration and the job site. They are responsible for leading homeowner/s and the volunteer work crew through the project. This includes setting the tone of mutual respect for all parties that encourages learning through doing; teaching and modeling safe tool operation; and managing the pace of the day to both allow for fellowship and project completion.

Duties Include

- Work with Home Repair Director to determine suitable home repair projects.
- Design solutions to accepted home repair projects.
- Determine material and volunteer needs for each project
- Organize and maintain tools, work trailers and vehicles.

- Lead work crews of volunteers and homeowners to complete necessary repairs.
- Teach and demonstrate best safety practices for jobsite and tool operation.
- Work cooperatively and collaboratively with other team members.

- At least 3-5 years' experience in construction.
- Knowledge of building science and solid carpentry skills.
- Able to lift 50 pounds.
- Able to work on a single story roof.
- Experience working with and leading teams.
- Experience with teaching.
